and Beyond”**

With Eydi's original and unique approach in this workshop, students will explore the endless possibilities of their creativity. This exciting and enthusiastic workshop will cover important material to help bring forth your personal artistic vision. Eydi Lampasona will demonstrate the use of acrylic gels, mediums and paints to create some very unique collage elements. Raised texture designs, gel transfers of your images, paint skins, gel textures, translucent glazes, transparent washes, and much more will be explored. Along with experimental watermedia, various papers, adhesives and *unusual* collage/assemblage materials will be introduced. A variety of glazing, painting, collaging techniques and layering methods will be explored through daily demonstrations and critiques.
