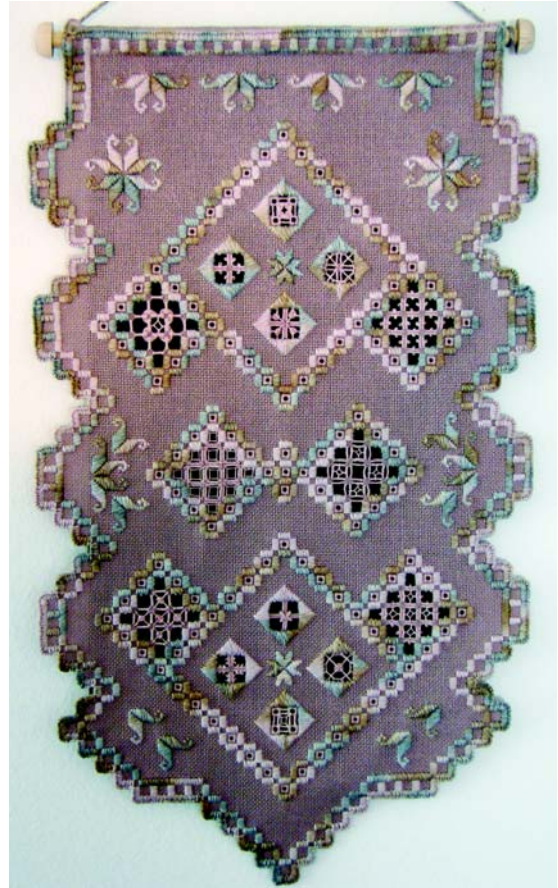
MORE OPTIONS...IN HARDANGER

Teacher: Dale Sokolow

Hardanger is a form of embroidery that originated in the Hardanger region of Norway. It is fun to do and can quickly become a quest to learn more and more filler stitches. In this class, the student will go beyond *Options...in hardanger*. We will review how to work such elements as diagonals, divided bars, blanket stitch, spider webs, Dove's eyes, square filets, and picots. These elements will be used in new fillers and in a variety of combinations and different ways.

For those who want to learn how to do these new filler stitches but who do not want to do a bell pull, instructions will be given on how to make the project into a framed wall hanging. A variety of fabrics and threads will be discussed so the student will be able to select her/his own fabrics and threads.

If you love Hardanger embroidery, you will find this class informative and fun. The instructions will also be a terrific resource for future Hardanger embroidery.
