

Beguiling Beading for the Befuddled Beader

Teacher: Kathleen Rake

This is for the beader who has some beading skills. The experienced beader will find ways to explore and hone their beading skills. You will build a notebook of herringbone, spiral twists, fringes, embellishing donuts/stations, with variations. Combine techniques into one project. Creativity and exploration is encouraged.

LESSON 1. Fringe, embellishments, and how to attach them

LESSON 2. Spiral ropes, how to square off the end, join in a circle etc.

LESSON 3. Herringbone ladders, variations, herringbone braid.

LESSON 4. Encasing donuts, shapes.

LESSON 5. Connecting all of the techniques to each other.

LESSON 6. Necklace using at least three of the lesson techniques.

Supplies needed: Various sizes/ types of beads, notebook supplies, thread, needles

Prerequisites: Basic knowledge of peyote stitching
